Carefully place the printed sticker on the desired spot. Always take the measurements to the sticker's edge.



2.

Attach the sticker to the spot with the pieces of masking tape. To ensure the desired stance (especially for long image) you should ply plenty of tape pieces to hold the product still during following steps.



3.

After finishing layout, remove some of masking tape pieces from one end of the product. Open the sticker between the background paper and the printed vinyl sticker. Next, cut off a piece of background paper (about 20-30% of the total length, but not absolutely more than 40cm).



4.

Press the printed image with semi soft paddle/trowel. As you move your instrument along the image, let the image to stick to the surface. To avoid undesired bubbles and wrinkles, don't let the image to touch the surface without pressure applied to them!



5.

Now a part of image is attached to the surface.



6.

Remove the rest of the masking tape pieces. Repeat the stage 4 with this now exposed piece of the sticker and at the same time pull background paper away step by step.



7.

Now the printed sticker image has been successfully applied to the target surface.

The same image in natural environment. The printed image installation is much easier to do compared cut text or image. Important thing is avoid leaving air bubbles under the sticker.



The small images installation is easy as pie. Unstick sticker from background paper – place it to desired spot – press sticker's end down with fingertips – press also sticker's other end down moving your fingertips up/down.

- INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION FOR PRINTED IMAGE -

If sticker film is metal pvc material, avoid steep angle with it
